# Changed security environment



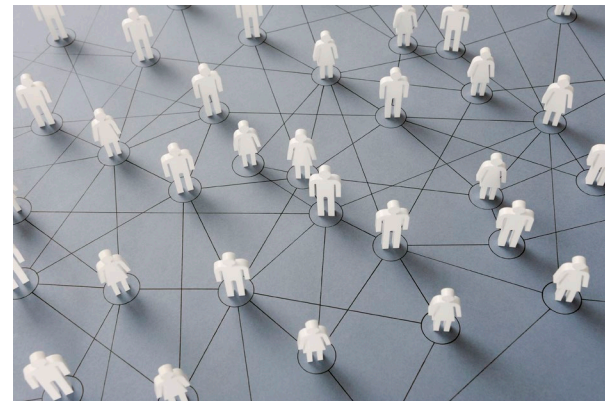
- Europe's security environment has changed permanently
- From globalization to geopolitics
- Reassessment of supply chains
- Economic decisions vs. security realities
- Strengthened role of states



# Strengthening Preparedness and Resilience



- Security and resilience concern us all
- Resilience is not a single measure or technical solution. It is a comprehensive mindset that extends from politics to everyday business and from international cooperation to local action.
- We need public-private partnerships based on trust, shared values, and long-term cooperation
- Private sector operators' have a key role in preparedness
- EU and NATO provide frameworks for broad collaboration. Bilateral and regional cooperation is also needed.



# Baltic Sea – Gateway to Northern Europe



- Common interest: an open, secure, and functional Baltic Sea
- Maritime transport is vital to both countries' economies
- Appr. 95% of Finland's foreign trade volume moves by sea
- Worrying phenomena in the Baltic Sea region is Russia's so-called "shadow fleet"
- Shadow fleet complicates maritime surveillance and increases risks in ports, sea lanes, and infrastructure
- It also poses security and environmental risks, and strategic threats
